Ye Shall Be Witnesses

"But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth." (Acts 1:8)

The First Word In The Great Commission Is "Go!"

Matthew 28:19,20 "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: 20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you:

the world. Amen."

William Carey accepted God's command as found in the Scripture above. He wanted to go to the Polynesian Islands, but God instead directed him to India. It was another man by the name of Henry Nott, that God wanted to send to these far away islands. He was a brick mason, who surrendered his life to Christ's will and when God burdened him, he followed God's call and arrived in Tahiti after a six month voyage in 1797. It was a barbarous place of worst of the vilest of sins.



Tahiti was ruled by an evil King name Pomare. He was estimated to have killed 2000 people and sacrificed them to his idols. His wife was a member of a class of people called the "areois." They blackened their bodies with charcoal and painted their faces red. Their only occupation was dancing, wrestling, boxing, and acts of behavior that were ridiculous but amusing to onlookers. Many murdered their children as soon as they were born. Pomares' wife killed three of their children.

The island was in a constant state of war. They burned their defeated enemies homes and killed all in the village. Hundreds were sacrificed on pagan altars to ensure victory in battle.

Children were sacrificed by throwing them alive to the sharks in the sea or into the fiery craters of volcanoes. Old people and those with handicaps would be taken to the seashore under the pretense of being given a bath. They would be thrown alive into a hole in the sand, covered with stones and sand then tramped down with their feet. They would then go away and divide up their personal belongings.

These were the people to whom God sent Henry Nott. Two of Knott's fellow missionaries were murdered, causing others to abandon their missions work leaving Henry Nott alone.

It would be twenty two years before he would see the first person saved. Pomare's son became king and after many years, finally received Christ as his Savior. On May 19, 1819, Nott baptized Pomare II. In a short time laws were passed that forbid all the cruel murders. The islands were at peace.

Adoniram Judson (1788-1850) sweated out Burma's heat for eighteen years without a furlough and six years without a convert. Enduring torture and imprisonment, he admitted that he never saw a ship sail without wanting to jump on board and go home. When his wife's health broke and he put her on a homebound vessel with the knowledge he would not see her for two full years he wrote in his diary, "Life is short. Millions of Burmese are perishing. I am almost the only person on earth who has attained their language to communicate salvation."

The Great Commission or The Great Omission?

An omission is "...the action of excluding or leaving out something." In Acts 1:8 we read the final command of our Lord. He said, "...ye shall be witnesses."

We Talk About The Things We Really Believe

Paul said, "I believed, and therefore have I spoken." (Second Corinthians 4:13). When we believe something strongly enough we talk to others about it. We could talk all day about our personal interests, vacation trips, fishing stories, etc. etc.

Why Don't We Witness About Our Saviour?

Who Is In Control?

In Acts 1:8 Jesus promised that we would, "...receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me..." If we are not witnessing for Him it is obvious that the Holy Spirit is not in charge.

The Problem of Fear

Our fearfulness also stems from the fact concerning whom is in control. Consider the following verses...

- Let's be honest, if we are using the excuse of fear we have, "...a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof..." (Second Timothy 3:5).

A Lack of Love For Christ

- John 14:21 Jesus said, "He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me"
- John 14:23 Jesus said, "If a man love me, he will keep my words."

If we truly love someone, we want to do all we can to please them. It is the goal of all who genuinely love the Lord, "...that he may please him..." (Second Timothy 2:4). Jesus said, "Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit..." (John 15:8). The purpose in winning the lost is to glorify God. The Bible says, "And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." (Philippians 2:11). First Corinthians 10:31 says, "...whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God."

Refusing To Follow Christ

Matthew 4:19 "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."

The promise is for all of us, if we follow we will fish. These unlearned Galilean fishermen followed and were transformed into some of the greatest "...fishers of men" that ever lived! Refusing To Abide In Christ

"Give Them Warning From Me"

Dinosaurs Had Fleas Too - Giant Ones, Fossils Show

WASHINGTON (AP) -- In the Jurassic era, even the flea was a beast, compared to its minuscule modern descendants. These pesky bloodsuckers were nearly an inch long.

New fossils found in China are evidence of the oldest fleas - from 125 million to 165 million years ago, said Diying Huang of the Nanjing Institute of Geology and Paleontology. Their disproportionately long proboscis, or straw-like mouth, had sharp weapon-like serrated edges that helped them bite and feed from their super-sized hosts, he and other researchers reported Wednesday in the journal Nature.

Scientists figure about eight or more of today's fleas would fit on the burly back of their ancient ancestor.

"That's a beast," said study co-author Michael Engel, entomology curator at the Natural History Museum at the University of Kansas. "It was a big critter. I can't even imagine coming home and finding my miniature schnauzer with one or more of these things crawling around on it."

The ancient female fleas were close to twice the size of the males, researchers found, which fits with modern fleas.

But Engel said it's not just the size that was impressive about the nine flea fossils. It was their fearsome beak capable of sticking into and sucking blood from the hides of certain dinosaurs, probably those that had feathers.

These flea beaks "had almost like a saw running down the side," Engel said. "This thing was packing a weapon. They were equipped to dig into something."

While the ancient fleas were big, they had one disadvantage compared to modern ones: Their legs weren't too developed. Evolving over time, fleas went from crawling to jumping, Huang said.

"Luckily for the land animals of the Mesozoic, these big flat fleas lacked the tremendous jumping capacity that our common fleas have," said Joe Hannibal of the Cleveland Museum of Natural History. He wasn't involved in the study, but praised it as useful and interesting.

Just finding the fleas was a stroke of luck, Huang said. He first found one in a Chinese fossil market and mentioned it to someone at his hotel. The other guest showed him a photo of another fossilized flea, telling

him it was from Daohugou in northeastern China, where there's a famous fossil bed from about 165 million years ago. Huang went there and found fleas preserved in a brownish film of volcanic ash. The grains of rock were so fine you could see antennae and other details of the fleas, he said.

Modern fleas get engorged after they feast on blood, but these didn't seem engorged, Engel said.

It shouldn't seem too surprising that there were large fleas more than 100 million years ago. If you go back even farther in time, ancestors of dragonflies and damsel flies had 3-foot wingspans, Engel said.

Is Dancing a Sin? -

Answer: In order for sin to exist, there must be law (Rom. 5: 13). Sin is lawlessness or the breaking of God's law (I Jn. 3: 4). Is dancing, then, in conflict with the law of Christ, the perfect law of liberty (Gal. 6: 2, Jas. 1: 25)?

There are two kinds of dance recognized in the Bible. One type of dance recorded in the Bible was a dance that involved the expression of joy in worship to God (Ps. 150: 4). David "danced before the Lord" (2 Sam. 6: 14). This is the same type dance that was performed when the prodigal son returned (Lk. 15: 25). It is important to notice that the dance here mentioned was male and female segregated. One work states, "Women seem generally to have danced by themselves, one often leading the rest" (ISBE, Vol. 2, pg. 1170). The New Testament does not teach dance as an act of worship today, I might add. The other dance is that kind of dance that was designed to stimulate the lust of the flesh (Ex. 32). This dance seemed to involve both men and women together and was performed in a spiritually opposed climate (Ibid.). Herodias' daughter also performed a sensual dance that was probably more of Roman origin and influence (Matt. 14: 6).



The Modern Dance

The modern dance, as a rule, is certainly not performed out of joy and worship. The drinking of alcohol, petting, and adultery are often the companions of the secular dance. Lasciviousness (aselgeia) is a biblical word used to describe and condemn wantonness and unbridled lusts (I Pet. 4: 3). The secular dance usually involves the male and female in improper physical contact. Consider Henry Thayer's comments on lasciviousness: "...indecent bodily movement, unchaste handling of males and females" (Greek-English Lexicon, pg. 79, 80). Hence, lasciviousness vividly describes the secular dance.

In short, the modern dance is a prelude to fornication and adultery. The dance comes under the heading of "the works of the flesh" (Gal. 5: 19, cp. I Jn. 2: 15-17).

Is There a Link Between Tattoos, Piercings, and Alcohol Consumption?

Scientists get under skin of tattooed tipplers From: AFP

FRENCH scientists have found evidence proving the stereotype that people who sport tattoos and piercings are heavier drinkers.

Alcohol tests performed on nearly 2,000 young men and women frequenting bars in the west of France



showed a strong correlation between body art and boozing, they said. "Pierced and/or tattooed individuals had consumed more alcohol in bars on a Saturday night than patrons in the same bars who were non-pierced and non-tattooed," said a study for the journal Alcoholism: Clinical and Experimental Research.

Previous research had shown that people with tattoos and piercings were more likely to engage in unsafe sex, fighting and heavy drinking, but this was the first such project to measure more alcohol per litre of exhaled breath.

The subjects were tested as they left 21 bars in four cities on four different Saturday nights on the Atlantic Coast of Brittany, an area with high alcohol consumption, said the researchers.

The men and women were asked whether they had tattoos or piercings and then asked to take a breathalyser test.

Tattoos and piercings are relatively new phenomena in France, and under-18s need permission from their parents.

The men tested were on average 20.6 years old and the women 20.2 years.

Of 1,081 men interviewed, 903 had no body art and an average measure of 0.18 milligrams of alcohol per litre of exhaled air, lower than France's 0.25 drink driving limit.

The figure increased to 0.19 in the 98 men with tattoos, 0.23 per cent for the 53 men with piercings, and 0.26 for the 27 men with both.

Of the 884 women, 537 had no body art and an average alcohol measure of 0.12, which rose to 0.14 for the 124 with tattoos, 0.20 for the 138 with piercings, and 0.24 for the 85 women with both tattoos and piercings.

Researcher Nicolas Gueguen of France's Universite de Bretagne-Sud, said the findings showed that teachers, parents and doctors should consider tattoos and piercings as potential "markers" for alcohol abuse.

But fellow scientist Myrna Armstrong from Texas Tech University, who reviewed the paper, cautioned against a "tendency to see a tattoo or piercing and automatically profile or stereotype that individual as a 'high-risk person'."

Did You Know That The Titanic Passengers All Died? -



On the centennial observance, a Florida man relates the heroic acts of one of the RMS Titanic victims to share the gospel of Jesus Christ. Lowell Lytle normally basks in the Florida sunshine, but during the busy tourist season he heads to Pigeon Forge, Tennessee, to play the role of Captain Edward John Smith at a Titanic museum attraction in the Great Smoky Mountains. There is an identical museum in Branson, Missouri.

Lytle says while playing the role of Capt. Smith, he relates a true story that does not appear in the popular Titanic movie -- the story of Baptist preacher John Harper, which is chronicled in the book The Titanic's Last Hero by Moody Adams. "That Baptist minister actually ran around the deck

shouting 'Women and children and unsaved people, get aboard the lifeboats,'" says Lytle. "He even took off his life vest and gave it to a man who was not a believer in Jesus Christ. He said: 'Here, take this. I don't need it. I'm not going down -- I'm going up!"

According to Lytle, Harper did not stop evangelizing to a non-believer he encountered while enduring the frigid waters of the Atlantic. "And Harper's last words were 'Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved.' A few weeks later in Hamilton, Ontario, that same man said I listened to Reverend Harper's last message and became a believer in Jesus Christ with two miles of water beneath me."

The liner went down on April 15, 1912, carrying 2,223 passengers. The sinking caused the death of 1,514 of them.

You are a sinking soul. Someday you will die like those on the Titanic. Actually all 2,223 passengers died-some that night, some years later. There is not one surviving passenger of the Titanic alive today. Are you saved?

New English Translation of Bible Omits 'Jesus Christ,' 'Angel'



A new translation of the Bible into English does not contain the name "Jesus Christ" nor the word "angel." It also prefers the word "emissary" over "apostle."

The Voice, a Bible that replaces "Jesus Christ" with terms like "Jesus the Anointed One," had its complete edition released by Thomas Nelson Publishing last month. Frank Couch, Thomas Nelson's lead editor on the project, told The Christian Post that the purpose of The Voice was to make the Gospel message easier to understand for modern audiences.

"The Voice has not claimed to be more accurate than any other translation, rather it is more easily understood than any other translation," said Couch.

"When translators are limiting themselves to conveying the complete essence of a word from the Hebrew or the Greek with one English word they have difficulty bringing in the nuances held in the original language."



Because other translations have more literal renderings, Couch believed they are "why it has been necessary for commentators and preachers to spend so much time explaining what the words in the original language mean before the lay reader can understand fully a text of Scripture."

"Because we have a more expansive translating technique we can more fully develop the English translation and thus bring out the more difficult nuances found in the original language," he explained.

The scholars and authors who collaborated on the translation say their intention was to help readers "hear God speaking."

"One of the byproducts of the information age in the church has been its focus on biblical knowledge. Many Bibles reflect this, packed with informative notes, charts, and graphs. While there's nothing wrong with having a deep knowledge; a personal connection and deep relationship are far better," according to hearthevoice.com. "The Voice is focused on

helping readers find (or rediscover) this connection with Him. Scripture is presented not as an academic document, but as an engaging story."

The idea for The Voice came in January 2004, when Thomas Nelson Publishing met with the Ecclesia Bible Society, whose leadership includes pastor Chris Seay of the Ecclesia Church in Houston, Texas. The project came in portions, with the complete New Testament according to The Voice being released in 2009.

The name comes from the Bible translation's rendering of the Greek Word logos in John 1:1. Although the typical English Bible translates logos to "Word," in this translation it is rendered "Voice." The first verse of John, which in the NIV reads "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God" becomes "Before time itself was measured, the Voice was speaking. The Voice was and is God."

A new video posted on the translation's Facebook further highlights that "The Voice offers an opportunity to hear afresh by telling the stories that have always been in the Bible in a beautiful and poetic way." It is written in screenplay format "so it's easy to follow or act out in a group."

Despite the approval of a major publisher like Thomas Nelson, which also sells other more established translations of the Bible, The Voice is not without its opponents, including many critical online reviews.

On the website "Life More Abundant," poster "Coralie" commented that the format of The Voice, which includes commentary in the body of the text, was a concern. "The ... effect of the inclusion of midstream commentary is the blurring of the line between inspired word and human opinion," wrote Coralie.

"My fear in our postmodern world is not that a new reader would take the commentary as the very word of God, but that he would read the words of God with the casual ease of another form of commentary."


The blog "Extreme Theology," an apologetics website, declared that The Voice was a "distorted version of the Bible."

"Unfortunately, not since the release of the Jehovah's Witnesses' New World Translation of the Greek Scriptures in 1950 has there been a bible published that so blatantly mangles and distorts God's Word in order to support a peculiar and aberrant theological agenda," reads a review on ET's site.

An Innocent Question

It was an innocent question, with no spin at all.

We were hosting two Bible college students on their summer missions trip. One day I asked them the following question, "How do you go about reaching unsaved teens where you live?"

They fell silent for several minutes. Finally, one of them replied, "We tried it once and it didn't work, so we gave it up."

I told them I hadn't intended to embarrass them, "I am just looking for ways to reach teens, and thought you might know something I don't know."

The other lad then ventured a reply, "I don't really know any unsaved young people."

"Don't you do any sports with kids that are lost, like maybe kick a football around or play basketball after school or anything? Aren't there any neighbourhood kids you hang out with?"

They both shook their heads. And then they told me that the only teens they knew were from Christian families, the ones they went to Sunday School with, the ones at the Christian school, at their church youth group, and the ones they met at Bible college.

Over the next few days we talked more about their isolation from the lost. When I asked them how this "greenhouse concept" of keeping saved people away from lost people related to the great commission, they opened up for me a real tin of worms. They said that all the evangelistic work done in their churches, such as preaching the gospel, witnessing, and doing missionary work were only done by people who had graduated from Bible college, and are ordained to the ministry and hold an office in the church.

So I asked them, "How much preaching have you done? You have come out to Australia on a summer missions team and pastors here are permitting you to speak in their pulpits. Has your pastor back home ever invited you to preach a sermon? Do you preach to the youth group at home?"

Both of them shook their heads. In fact one of them told me in all seriousness that, in his church, you need a degree to pass the offering plate. Of course, that IS in the town where the university is (!!!!!!!) So, having been shot at quite a few times, and having learned that after a while some of the bullets go in the same holes and don't hurt much, I bearded the lion in his den. I wrote to all the pastors of all the lads we had that year and begged them to give them some experience before they come out here.

How many replies did I receive? You don't really want to know. Well, okay, it was zero, zilch, nada. Not even one.


And that set me thinking. For me, that is a long slow process. Like maybe 10 years until I finally figured out what it all means.

It means we now have Eugenics In The Churches.

You may have never heard of eugenics. (It comes from the Greek word "eugenes", which means "well-born, of good stock, of noble race," from eu- "good" + genos "birth". It is a good Bible word, found in three verses in the New Testament, Luke 19:12, Acts 17:11, and I Cor.1:26, and is translated "nobleman, and noble." Well worth a word study!)

The Origins of Eugenics - An embarrassment to evolutionists!

So where did the Eugenics movement come from? Charles Darwin promoted the concept that the human race should be improved (that is, that man's evolution should be accelerated) by selective breeding. After all, he reasoned, if man is nothing more than an animal, and we use selective breeding to improve many animal species, why not legislate the selective breeding of man? It simply means that intelligent, beautiful, and skillful people should be allowed to reproduce themselves and ignorant, clumsy, ill-mannered, criminally inclined people should not be allowed to reproduce.



Darwin's novel idea caught on quickly with his family. His own children and his cousin, Francis Galton, founded the eugenics movement after reading On the Origin of Species. Galton invented the word "eugenics." Darwin's son, Leonard was the president of the First International Congress of Eugenics.

The idea caught on quickly and spawned groups all over the world. Many well known people embraced the idea. Ernst Haeckel, George Bernard Shaw, Alexander Graham Bell, John Kellogg (whose brother, Will, invented Kellogg cornflakes), H. G. Wells, Winston Churchill (who attended the First International Congress on Eugenics), Henry Osborn (head of the American Museum of Natural History and president of the Second International Congress of Eugenics), and Theodore Roosevelt supported the movement. Margaret Sanger, founder of Planned Parenthood said, "More children from the fit; less from the unfit--that is the chief issue of birth control."

Many believers in evolution formed groups like The Station for Experimental Evolution at Cold Spring Harbor, New York, funded by the Carnegie Foundation to the tune of millions of dollars.

There was also The Eugenics Records Office which said, "Its first mission was to identify the most defective and undesirable Americans, estimated to be at least 10 percent of the population." Ultimately, the eugenics program in America forced the sterilization of 60,000 "inferior" people. Abortion, infanticide, and euthanasia all find their roots in the eugenics of Charles Darwin.

Christian Eugenics, Is There such a Thing? -

The basic premise of Darwinian Eugenics is "to advance the human race through selective breeding." The basic premise of Christian Eugenics is "to build the church by selective reproduction," that is by permitting only those who are the "nobility," the "elite," to carry out the great commission. The very subtle basic premise of Christian Eugenics is that intelligent, erudite, highly educated, eloquent, refined, well-mannered Christians will produce better quality converts.

Is there such a movement? Consider the following facts:

There Is A True Nobility - Every saved person is born of God!

We recognise only the true nobility of the New Birth. "Beloved, now are we the sons of God!!!!!!" (I John 3:2) Every born again person has this nobility since God is his father. The maniac of Gadarra, Saul, the former persecutor of the churches, the woman taken in adultery, the thief on the cross, and millions more are the true noblemen and women of God through Christ. Simply through repentance and faith in Jesus Christ, we are born into God's family. That is the true nobility!

There Is A Man Made, False Nobility -

Again and again in church history we read of pastors, of seminary professors, and of presidents of denominations who decided that the new birth was not enough to qualify a Christian to reproduce himself by winning others to Christ. Before they can preach the gospel or witness to their neighbour a certain Baptism must be added, a second blessing, a higher level of education, a particular denominational tag, a style of clothing or hairstyle, or an ordination by the approved doctors of religion. What they do not tell their hearers is that this is the old elitism of the Nicolaitans, whose deeds and doctrines the Lord said he hates!

Have you observed it anywhere?

Two of my preacher friends here in Australia attended a Leadership Conference some years ago. They were both bush preachers, brought to Christ in little churches far from the Big Smoke. Neither one of them owned a suit. So they wore the best they had to the conference, RM Williams boots, moleskins (dress jeans), open collared shirts, and Akubra hats. Would you like to guess what kind of reception they received from the 3 piece suit reverends? Elitism is alive and well in IB circles.

How Did Eugenics Ever Sneak Into Our Churches? -

As little store front churches grew into large churches, and poor churches became wealthy churches, and simple little Bible colleges became liberal arts universities, as their professors got their state accreditation, and the seminaries' alumni became celebrities, and success began to be measured by size, it became politically correct to manage the gene pool of the churches.

No longer was it acceptable for the Lord Jesus Christ to tell the maniac of Gadarra to "go home to thy friends, and tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had compassion on thee." Instead, he was told by the elitists to pack his bags and head off to the seminary at Jerusalem and get himself a briefcase full of diplomas, a three piece suit, a laurel wreath in elocution, and the pulpit mannerism of gently waving his hand in the air.

Then, and only then would he be permitted to evangelise Decapolis.

I am finding example after example in the New Testament of new converts who immediately began evangelising the lost. For it is written, I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent.

Where is the wise? where is the scribe? where is the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom: But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God. Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: That no flesh should glory in his presence.

But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord."

I had the privilege forty five years ago of pastoring a little church in the Ozark mountains in Missouri. Most of the preachers I met there had never seen the inside of a Bible college. They would be called "Rednecks" today. But God had done a work in their hearts, and they could preach! And they could win souls! And they could plant churches in the rocky soil of Stone County!

And they'd never hear of Eugenics!

Theirs was the True Nobility of the New Birth!

That'll do me!
